What is the Autism Spectrum Cartoon?

The Autism Spectrum Cartoon is a cartoon made by a parent to explain that the Autism Spectrum is not liner – like many people think it is – but rather it is a circle of different skills, and a young person will fall into these skills set at different places.

Why would you use the Autism Spectrum Cartoon?

The Autism Spectrum Cartoon will be used as a better way of explaining the autism spectrum to anyone. Some people think that you can be "more" or "less autistic" and this is simply not true.

How does the Autism Spectrum Cartoon relate to autistic people?

The Autism Spectrum Cartoon relates to autistic people because it shows how the spectrum actually is – not how other's view it.

Some top tips for using the Autism Spectrum Cartoon

- Where you are on the spectrum can also be influenced by the environment the individual finds themselves in such as home, school or outside.
- Where you are on the spectrum can also be influenced by the demand an individual is under.
